- Conduct evaluation of GWEP sites to inform future HRSA programming.




Overview of GWEP-CC Participation & Initiatives

- Today, I30 people representing 43 GWEPs are in attendance for our 5th Annual Preconference!
- Two rounds of consultation funding were disseminated to 13 GWEPs, and 7 GWEPs participated in a GITT-PC conference in September 2017.
- Network Meetings were hosted by **7 GWEPs** in August 2017 and **6 GWEPs** in June 2018, with **30 GWEPs** participating in total.
- Stipends awarded to **all GWEPs** between 2016 and 2018 were used for educational resources that enhanced your programs.
- **GWEP grantees** participated in educational webinars on topics such as abstract submissions, age-friendly health systems, patient outcomes data, and successes from the opioid supplement.
- Provided advocacy training during GWEP-CC Preconference Sessions and advocated for increased appropriations, GWEP and GACA funding, and embedded GWEP/GACA authorization language into proposals developed for Title VII funding.
